# Heirloom Dresses, Aprons & A-line Dresses

Chest circumference along the breast line; begin center chest, under the arm, around the back, under the other arm, back to the starting point:

The measurement from the edge of the shoulder before it curves down into the arm horizontally across the collar bones to the edge of the other shoulder:

Arm circumference one inch above elbow:

Finished length from the base of the neck where a shirt begins, straight down the back to the desired length of the dress:

### Button-on-suits & Bubbles

Chest circumference along the breast line; begin center chest, under the arm, around the back, under the other arm, back to the starting point:

The measurement from the edge of the shoulder before it curves down into the arm horizontally across the collar bones to the edge of the other shoulder:

Waist circumference right below the belly button:

Circumference of one upper thigh at its thickest point:

The measurement from the base of the neck where a shirt begins, straight down the back, between the legs to the center of the crotch area:

#### **Overshirts**

Chest circumference along the breast line; begin center chest, under the arm, around the back, under the other arm, back to the starting point:

The measurement from the edge of the shoulder before it curves down into the arm horizontally across the collar bones to the edge of the other shoulder:

Waist circumference right below the belly button:

Finished length of shorts - measure from right below the waistband (do NOT include the waistband) straight down the outside leg seam to the desired length Note: The short measurements are much easier if he is wearing a pair of shorts

#### Bonnets

Headband measurement from the bottom of one earlobe up over the head staying 2-2.5 inches from the hairline that frames the face down to the bottom of the other ear lobe.

## Bloomers

Waist circumference right below the belly button:

Circumference of one upper thigh at its thickest point:
